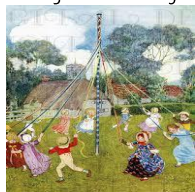

The children will be learning about Plants. They will be completing a Bean Diary. They will also look at Seeds.



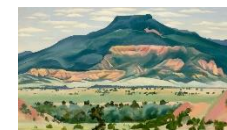
## ST GEORGE'S DAY
