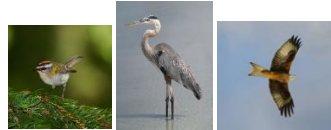
Daily Phonics Sessions.

Please help the children to practise their weekly spellings at home regularly. You can do this in lots of fun ways, e.g. colourful spellings, quizzes, word hunts etc.

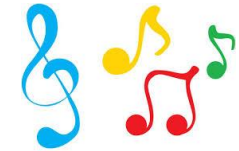
MATHS
